Did you know...

PVC cards are shrink wrapped in packs of 100 quantity for a reason. It is to maintain the best printing quality surface when customizing the cards in a direct-to-card printer. Care should be taken not to scratch the cards when opening the wrapping, especially when using a sharp object. Once a card package is open place the entire stack in the card hopper. If all cards do not fit, place the remaining cards into a zip top baggie to keep the cards clean.
