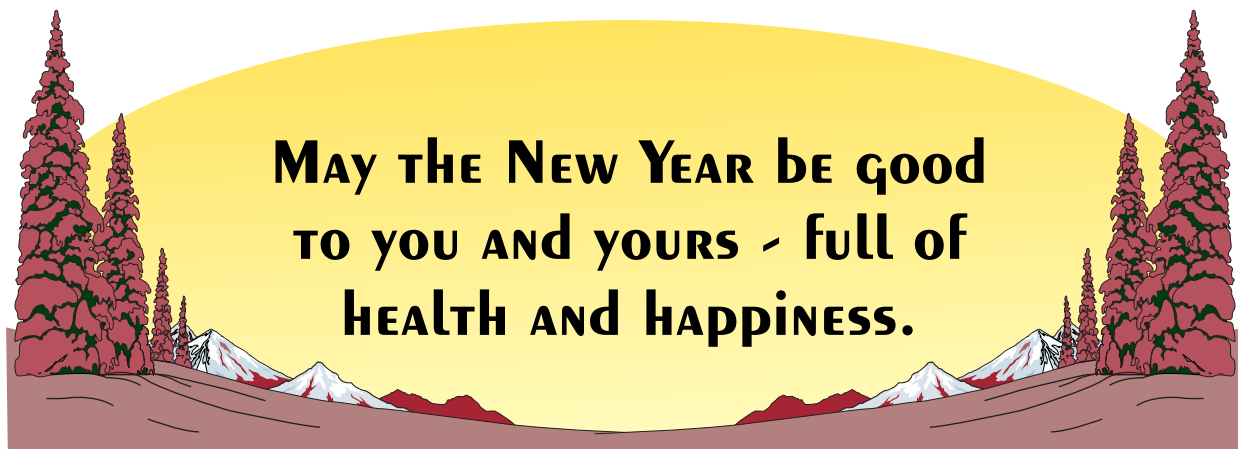

Demystifying PVC Card Terms

Just what do CR80/79, 30 mil, graphics quality, shrink wrapped, and composition terms such as, ABS and PET mean?

In an effort to help "demystify" the most common card terms, read on. As you will discover, not all cards are equal.

CR80 vs. Cr79 (Size)

The industry term Cr80, refers to standard credit card size dimensions, which are 2.125" W x 3.375" L, while Cr79 denotes a card slightly smaller than a credit card. Actual dimensions of a Cr79 card are 2.0625" W x 3.3125" L and it is most commonly adhered to another card such as a clamshell prox card.

Mil (Card Thickness)

PVC cards are available in a wide range of mil (one-thousandth of an inch) thickness and each has its own specific use. The most common are listed below.

- 10 mil (or .010") cards are commonly used when card longevity is not a concern, such as when producing a temporary or visitor pass. They are ideal for anything that will only be needed for a short amount of time.

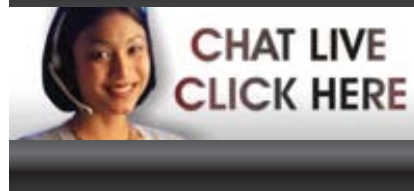
